

MSDS Information

This product is considered an "article" under the Hazard Communication Standard and is exempt from the MSDS requirement.

As defined by the Hazard Communication Standard any chemical which can cause a physical or health hazard. This determination is made by the manufacturer, as described in 29 CFR 1910.1200(d). Listed below is the section of the standard that defines an "article".

Manufacturers are not required to provide MSDS's for chemicals not covered under the HCS. OSHA realized that manufacturers often provide MSDS's for reasons other than those meeting the requirements of the HCS and that this can cause confusion to downstream users. Employers should contact the manufacturer when they question the hazard status of a chemical.

This product is exempt from California Proposition 65. This product does not contain any materials that approach reportable thresholds of exposure.



An "article" is defined by HCS as "a manufactured item other than a fluid or a particle, (I) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture. (II) which has end use function dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use, and (III) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than a very small quantities, minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical and does not pose a physical hazard to health risk of employees"
